*Died aged 33 in childbirth of stillborn child: 3 children + 1 stillborn*

- Mayoress opened Victoria Bridge, 21 June 1870
- Performed in charitable concerts for inmates of Destitute Asylum in Kintore Avenue, the Lunatic Asylum on North Terrace, and the Orphan Home near St John's Church in Halifax Street
